

AMERICAN BAPTIST MEN OF NEBRASKA SEMINARY SCHOLARSHIPS:

ABMNE presents scholarships for students attending seminary. Program guidelines:

- I. Academic
 - a. Student must be eligible for enrollment in an accredited seminary

- II. Statements from applicant
 - a. There shall be evidence of Christian experience and personal faith.
 - b. There shall be a statement or evidence of educational plans and goals.
 - c. There shall be a statement providing evidence of participation and leadership in applicant's local church.
 - d. There shall be a statement of call to ministry and career plans.

- III. References
 - a. The applicant shall receive permission from two references and one of these will be a pastor. The applicant will supply the names and addresses with email address of these two references on the application.
 - b. The letters of reference should include the following.
 - i. Perception of applicant's leadership ability.
 - ii. Commitment to ministry.
 - iii. Commitment to educational preparation.

- IV. Funds will be issued to the seminary for distribution.

- V. Preferential sequence for granting seminary scholarship.
 - a. Nebraska Baptist student to Central Seminary.
 - b. Nebraska Baptist student to any ABC seminary.
 - c. Nebraska Baptist student to any other accredited seminary.
 - d. Student from outside Nebraska to Central Seminary.
