Registration

Complete the form completely. When completing the form, you will have the option to register for all or part of the conference. The form cannot be submitted unless all required questions are answered.

Following successful submission of the form, you will receive an email with an invoice listing the amount due for the conference and where to send your payment. The deadline for registration is May 25th.

<u>Cost</u>

The cost for the entire weekend is \$170 which includes two nights of lodging and five meals. If you are unable to be present for the entire conference, you may register for only the time that you will be attending and be charged accordingly:

- Housing: \$63 per night
- Meals: \$10 per meal

Lodging

We will be staying in the hotel-like Overlook Lodge. Our meetings will be held in the conference rooms in the same building. All bedding and towels are provided.

The available rooms are listed below. There is no elevator, but if assistance is needed, there will be plenty of help to move you into your room!

If numbers require it, three ladies will be housed in the rooms with three beds. You will be asked to list the roommates you wish to stay with on the registration form.

1st Floor:

- 1 handicapped room
- 3 rooms with two beds
- 2 rooms with three beds

2nd Floor:

- 3 rooms with two beds
- 10 rooms with three beds

<u>Arrival</u>

Check in at the camp will begin at 3:00 pm on Friday. Hostesses and camp staff will be available, if need be, in getting your items to the Overlook Lodge and into your rooms. Registration will be at the lodge.

Schedule at a Glance

<u>Friday</u>: Devotions at 5:30 followed by dinner. The evening will finish with an ice breaker and s'mores on the back patio!

<u>Saturday morning</u>: Devotions at 8:15 followed by breakfast. The worship will begin at 9:15 with music and words from Brittany followed by a time of discussion. The annual business meeting will start at 10:30, followed by lunch.

<u>Saturday afternoon</u>: After another time of worship and discussion we will have an afternoon of filling the toiletry bags, a fun fashion show for everyone to participate in and some time to be outside (weather permitting)! <u>Saturday evening</u>: After dinner, music and devotion we will have a time of fun playing "Crazy Bridge"! <u>Sunday morning</u>: We will have

morning worship with communion in the camp chapel.

- Camp/lawn chair
- Drinks and snacks for personal use or to share. There is a small kitchen with refrigerator in the lodge for our use.

Missional Opportunities

As was done last year, we will be collecting personal toiletry items for domestic abuse programs in our areas. Items to bring include: full-size body wash, shampoo, lotion and toothpaste. (We have ample toothbrushes!) Bags will be provided for packaging as you take them home. Boxed snacks will be distributed to area programs also.
